### **1. Activity Report**

This was followed by a session on visualization which helped the teachers to relax and unwind. The teachers then shared their problems with Ms. Chaudhary, who listened to them very attentively and tried to find a solution for them. The workshop concluded with meditation where the teachers got a chance to reconnect with themselves. All in all it was a very refreshing session that helped the teachers to detoxify their souls through a self-reflection.
