1. Activity Report

Date : 01 September 2016

Details : Sir Padampat Singhania Education Centre organized a cleanliness campaign on Swachh Bharat in the school premises on 6th September, 2016. The programme commenced with a special assembly on Swachh Bharat where the students displayed slogans

related to cleanliness and inspired all to become active participants in this mission. Students delivered a speech remembering Mahatma Gandhi's thought on the importance of cleanliness and sanitation and Prime Minister Narendra Modi's effective nationwide execution of the Swachh Bharat Campaign. Details : Foundation Block of our school organized a fun filled session of activities for the students, details of which are mentioned as under:

- **Paint with Ice** – 06.09.16 – Day 1- To provide a sensory, fun and unique painting experience 'Ice painting' activity was organized in the Foundation Block on 6th September, 2016. The activity began with the explanation of primary colours followed by the thrilling ice experiment where they were given coloured ice cubes and the chart papers to paint with the ice and magically creating a new colour by mixing two of the primary colours. Most of them painted until the ice melted. They also learnt about the states of water through games conducted in the class room and water fascinating fun.
- **Tooth paste experiment** – 07.09.16 - Day 2 – 'The healthier the teeth , the happier you look' To develop the habit of oral hygiene for strong and healthy teeth 'Tooth paste experiment' was conducted in the Foundation Block on 7th September, 2016. The discussion began with the explanation of how and why to brush teeth followed by the simple experiment using a boiled white egg along with the one soaked in the cola overnight. It was a fun activity for our children as they could see and imagine how a nice pearly tooth can turn to a dour yellow or brown tooth if not brushed properly. They thoroughly enjoyed the brushing activity and learnt the right way to take care of their teeth and the importance of eating healthy food apart from brushing and flossing.
- **My Shadow** – 08.09-16 – Day 3 – To provide our children the foundational understanding of light by enabling them to explore how light interacts with different objects and to discover relationships between light and shadow 'My Shadow activity' was organized in the Foundation Block on 8th September, 2016. The discussion started with a riddle followed by the questions of what is a shadow and how it is formed. They had fun while conducting different experiments with the shadows like interacting while performing simple actions through jumping , skipping, hopping and swimming, observing the sizes by bringing the objects closer and taking far away from the light, playing 'Guess

the Shadow' game with their teachers, shadow drawing of their favourite animal and making various projections with their hands amongst which cat, horse, duck, eagle, butterfly, crocodile and bunnies were the things imagined and projected.

- **Make your own moon** – 09.09.16 – Day 4 – To engage students curiosity about the moon and to help build a foundation for learning about the predictability of the moon phases 'Make your own moon' activity was organized in the Foundation Block on 9th September, 2016. The priority was to make them notice and describe what the sky looks like at different times. The activity was fun and interesting as our little ones were thrilled to learn about the fact that the appearance of the moon is a little different every day, but looks the same again about every four weeks. Our little astronauts learnt about the phases of the moon while drawing pictures in their art books and by making cookie moons.

Details : A One day workshop on School Programme Overview was conducted by the British Council Connecting Classrooms on 8th September, 2016 at Guru Nanak Modern School, Bithoor Road, Kalyanpur, Kanpur. The workshop commenced with the lighting of the lamp and Saraswati Vandana followed by a welcome address and an introduction by Mr. Balwinder Singh, the Principal of GNMS.
