Details : Our school was the Centre for the conduction of AISSE / AISSCE – 2019 exams. Our school was the examination centre for following 05 CBSE schools of Kanpur –

Total 729 candidates were registered for class XII at our school. This year CBSE introduced lots of changes at all levels from receipt of confidential material from custodian to distribution of Question Papers to candidates where they were asked to witness the tamper proof parcels.

- An application introduced by CBSE for smooth conduction of examination was used to capture images at 3 stages. That helped us all in fair conduction of exam.
- Teachers from all 05 schools visited on the examination day for invigilation duties.
- Teachers from all wings of our school were deputed for invigilation duties and they did justice to the task assigned.
- This year observer's were deputed to each examination centres to streamline the examination process. 03 Observers who were principals of different schools visited our centre and found all work done by our examination team was upto the mark. They appreciated the efforts of the team.

Event : Computer Workshop

Details : A five-day computer workshop on ‘Python and it’s usage in day to day computing’ for the upliftment of the technical standards was held from 05 – 09 March, 2019 in the school premises by Mr. R.K. Kamra and Mr. Mitranand Mishra.

Two teachers from Kota and eight teachers from Kanpur attended the workshop for the school’s upcoming computer curriculum.

On Day 1 the topics covered were basics of the interpreter Jupiter using Anaconda. Along with it topics like operators, sequential statements (if, if-else, elif), loops (for , while) , type casting , user defined functions were discussed and explained. The resource persons helped the members in making some simple programs.

Day 2 started with coding practice reviewing topics taught the previous day. Logical operators was the next topic covered. In the later part strings were explained with the concept of loops and slicing. It was very interesting to write the code of 20-30 lines of another language in Python language in a

few lines. After strings, the facilitators discussed List, Dictionaries and Tuples. Menu driven programming was the major attraction of the day which taught us to run more than one code simultaneously.

Day 3 of the workshop continued with a review of day 2 . It was followed by the introduction of the concept of File Handling which is basically used for the purpose of handling textual data in Python. Recursion the next topic helped the attendees to write the code to frame stacks and to access data in LIFO manner. Packages and Modules were taught which are helpful in reusing the code. Searching was explained to make the data analysis more clear using both library and logics.

On Day 4, Date / Time functions were introduced with hands on session of the same. The package turtle was the next in queue. Sorting is a way to arrange data in a sequential ascending / descending order . The same concept was taught using bubble, sequential, selection sort. A CSV file is primarily used to transport data between two databases of different formats through a computer program. Its concept was introduced to handle large textual data in computing.

On day 5 the focus was to work on certain video / sound related applications. There was a review of library related to python 3.x. The participants were taught to handle Excel sheets using python's pyplot, mathLab, numpy and pandas. Web scraping is a term used to describe the use of a program or algorithm to extract and process large amounts of data from the web. For the development of web sites using Django this will be a useful tool.

The members on the final day thanked Mr. R.K. Kamra and Mr. Mitranand Mishra for the wonderful 5 days session. The major need of today is to upgrade ourselves as per the latest technologies and trends so that being teachers, we can uplift the standards of the students which is the need of the society in general. It was really encouraging to have such a training schedule in the school premises.
