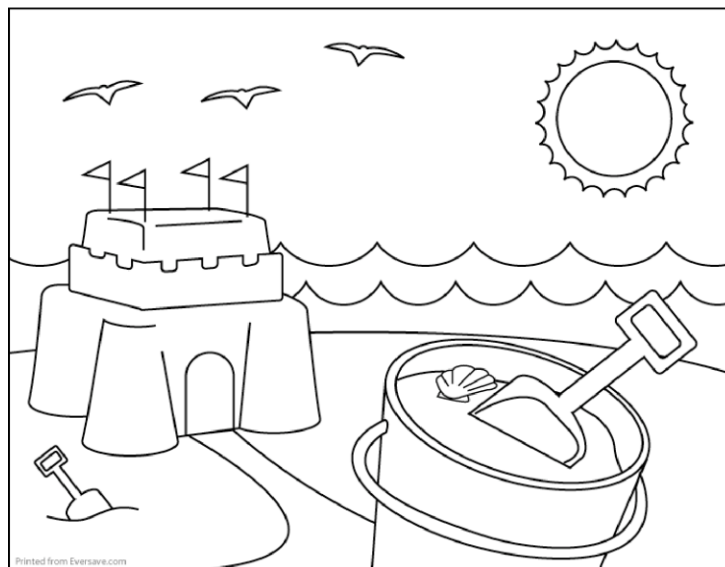
## **FUN WITH READING AND STORY NARRATION**

Best narrator will be acknowledged.

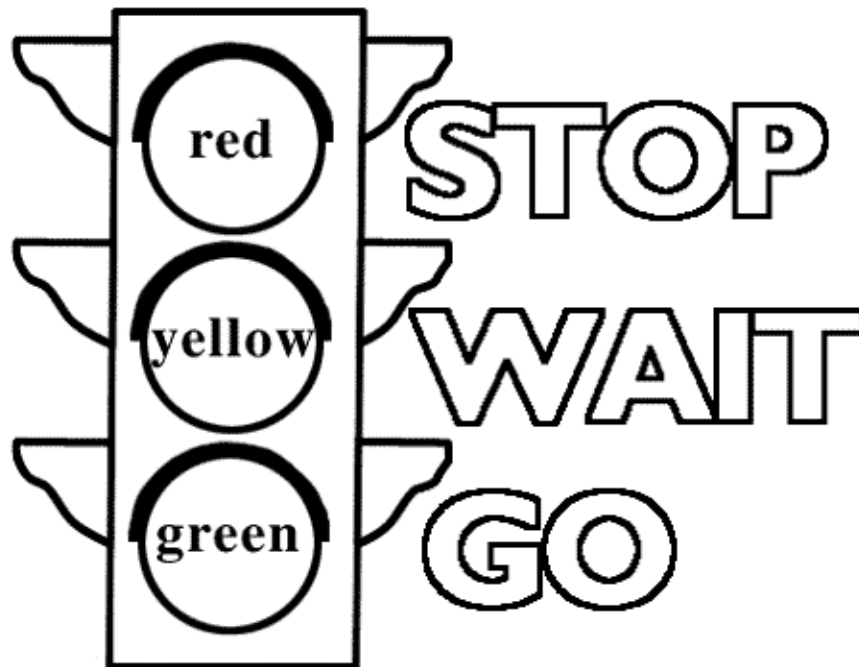
## **HYGIENE**




























## My Summer Bucket List
