Details : Keeping up with its tradition of providing holistic education to its children, Sir Padampat Singhania Education Centre organised a special motivational session for the students on 13th November, 2018. It was an enriching session that was presided by the internationally acclaimed adventurer and explorer, Mr. Ajeet Bajaj, the first Indian to ski both the North and the South Pole within the course of a single year and to have completed the Polar Trilogy comprising skiing to the North Pole, the South Pole and across the Greenland Icecaps. He is also the first Asian to have rafted and kayaked some of the most challenging rivers across six continents. Feted by the Indian Armed Forces, the travel industry as well as the government, Mr. Bajaj has received the highest civilian award 'Padma Shri' in 2012 and 'Hall of Fame' award from the Adventure Tour Operators Association of India in 2010. His expedition to the Mt. Everest with his daughter Ms. Deeya Bajaj not only brought him laurels but also proved that a girl can reach the highest summits, if given the right opportunities. The session focused at helping children learn to push themselves beyond the boundaries, dream big, set goals and face the challenges head on. Mr. Bajaj highlighted the major components of growth – physical fitness, mind-set and the right attitude. He also talked about the real time effects of global warming and laid stress on the contributions that the young students can make to conserve the environment. It was fascinating to see the educational shift from conventional books to the enriching life skills.

Event : **Workshop on Python**
Venue : **SPSEC**
Resource Person: **Mr. R.K. Kamra – Senior Vice President/Head Global Customer Delivery – JK Technosoft Ltd.**

Details : A workshop on Python, a new programming and coding language, was conducted in our school. The Resource Person was Mr. R.K. Kamra – Senior Vice President/Head Global Customer Delivery – JK Technosoft Ltd. The following were suggestions by Mr. Kamra –

- Up to standard 5, his suggestion was that there is minimal theory and only game. Using games, kids can learn – how to use mouse/Keyboard. In addition, switching on/off the computer and knowing the computer parts when looking at these.
- From 6th onwards, we should start the Python programming. Again, stress should be developed. Simple Python programs like arithmetic operation, output to Printer / Screen, simple If then else, simple loops.
- In Standard 7 / 8 will be similar but complexity would increase. By this time, students could write useful program using Python library. The Python library is open source and available free. Sample programs could be Voice recognition and directing computer to do specific tasks using voice. We could explore image recognition, payment gateway library, Google Maps library and so on.
- The course for 6 – 11 standard should be designed in such way that by 11th standard, students have covered all topics as needed in CBSE 12th exam. In 12th standard, students have learnt

everything but 12th will be used for refreshing and mock tests. In fact, the similar things can be done for other subjects like Phy/Chem/Maths and use 12th standard time for mock test / revision and IIT exam preparation.

- In classes IX to XII the students can write to solve simple business problems like instructing computer to perform some task using voice recognition library, or Route optimization for sales man travelling to many cities (like Delhi, Bombay, Kolkata, Pune, Banaras etc) use goggle maps for this. Other simple task could payment gateway for transferring money (use google pay), identify vehicle jumping red lights at traffic and inform the driver of fine using SMS. These simple projects can be showcased in inter school competition and will get recognized. The recognitions could be published to do PR activities.
- If we can follow the approach of finishing the 12th standards syllabus by 11th and use one year for mock test / revision / JEE, we can get better success. In fact, we hire some real good teachers from market (may be expensive) who are into tuition business, School can start the integrated course for Schooling with JEE exam. If the teachers are good, we retain good students, I am sure we can multiple the IIT success rate by 10 in 2-4 years' time. This may lead to KJKSS school to be rated as top school in Kanpur and then we aim for India.

In addition to these, schools today also have to face over demanding parents, increasing interference of regulatory authorities and mindless activism of groups with vested interests. No wonder, the school leadership today is overwhelmed and bewildered. In this scenario, schools will have to search for new ways to deal with mounting pressures. One of the most practical and positive approaches to dealing with many of these serious concerns faced by schools is guidance based education. Although Guidance and Counselling services have been recognized and accepted as an integral part of the total education process in India, due to paucity of professionally trained counsellors, majority of schools in the country do not have even a part time counsellor. Even in schools where a counsellor is appointed, she cannot single handedly achieve much. Until and unless all the stakeholders in the school become guidance oriented, the schools cannot cope with the challenges they face today. In order to achieve this, schools have to equip their teachers through continuous training. Similarly, student development programs also should be an essential part of the school guidance program. Parents also need to be orientated on a continuous basis. ICTRC, under Project Paradigm has been organizing conferences, seminars, workshops and short term courses for school principals in the area of Guidance and Counselling all over the country for more than twenty-five years. By attending these programs, schools are benefiting immensely. However, this is only the first step. After attending ICTRC community programs under

project Paradigm, schools have always wondered how they can further engage with ICTRC on a continuous basis. Project Paradigm Partnership Program is an attempt to address this concern.
