## The following points were discussed -

- I. A meeting was held of the teachers of classes IX and X with Mr. Partho Kar and Mr. N.P.Agarwal to discuss the performance of the students and the targets achieved till now in the session 2018 19.
  - 1. Introduction of Google Classroom digital app for giving assignments to students was encouraged and appreciated.

- 2. Sending circulars and messages to popularize the school website among parents to view school curriculum and lesson plans etc.
- 3. Introducing experiential teaching in classes 3,4,5 was suggested. Buy 3D glasses for students for the same.
- 4. All teachers should use Google app to browse for appropriate videos on the topics they are teaching and incorporate them in their lesson plan. Sharing the link with students as well.
- 5. Within a year or two every class room in the school should be digitized. There should be no need to write on the board.
- 6. Establishing Video conferencing link between Kanpur and Kota so that teachers may conduct classes.
- 7. Curriculum mapping and alignment should be done to ensure that the learning outcome of each class is appropriate to make relevant changes wherever required. It will ensure excellent results at all levels.
- 8. Teachers have to upgrade themselves to keep abreast of the latest trends in education.
- 9. Discussing the academic performance , it was suggested that all students and mathematics teachers should connect to Khan academy and view/ practice math lessons.
- 10. Teachers should conduct a class to apprise the students of ideal answers to score 100/100, 80/100, 50/100 or fail. This will help them to frame better answers.
- 11. Class 10<sup>th</sup> teachers were asked to select 5 students who can score a 100 out of 100 in all subjects in class 10.
  - (a) A teacher should become the mentor of each of them and design a program for them to achieve the set goal.
  - (b) Involve the parents of these students too in this endeavor.
  - (c) Do the same for the bottom 50 students in order to enhance their performance.
- 12. To be strict with the students of class 9<sup>th</sup> while grading and granting promotions to ensure excellent results in class 10.
- 13. Make parents a partner in progress. Invite them every 2 months to discuss the achievements of their wards.
- 14. The efforts of the teachers were appreciated and they were asked to keep up the good work.
