**Date** : **02 April 2019**  
**Event** : **Board Examination – Physical Education**

Dr. Dass informed the students of the scope available in the professional courses of Mass Media, Art & Designing, Banking, Advertising, Designing and Film Making, Corporate Communication etc. Further, guidance and information on courses available in the International Universities and the International Scholarships that can be availed was also provided to the students.

The session culminated with a Question & Answer round wherein the resource person clarified several issues regarding careers as well as reiterated the requirement for parental support in making the right choice. The highlights of the session were encapsulated in the handout distributed to students after the session.
