1. Activity Report :

Date : 03 – 04 September, 2019 & 19th September, 2019
Event : ‘Storybeatz’
Venue : Foundation Block
Classes Involved: Root, Bud & Bloom

Details : To build the listening and literacy skills of our children the ‘Storybeatz’ activity was conducted on 3rd September, 4th September and 19th September, 2019 in the Foundation Block. The idea behind this session was to make learning a fun and a collaborative activity by encouraging the parent involvement, highlighting the importance of spending just few minutes a day, where people of all ages share the pleasure of reading and sharing stories together. Guest Parents of classes Root, Bud and Bloom were invited to address the children and narrate the stories to them. Following suggestions were made:

Senior Section :

1. Google class room to be more effective by documenting all records of video links, quizzes and question banks given to the students. Question banks should be provided in all classes right from class 9 to class 12.
2. List the students in three categories :a) low achievers ; b) middle achievers and c) high achievers according to their academic performance.
3. Parents should be intimated about the day to day progress of their wards.
4. Pattern of assessment of class 6 onwards should be revamped with the same as is followed in classes 11 and 12 in boards.
5. Byjus to be subscribed for few classes.
6. Teachers must register themselves in free online courses of foreign universities.
7. Videos to be created by the teachers of the school.
8. A good librarian can be appointed for the purpose of downloading videos and giving to respective subject teachers.
9. Invite dignitaries as chief guests depending on the events.
10. Can even invite the highly educated parents who are keen to help in the improvement of the system.
11. Students should carry a tit-bit book to develop a diary and maintain it.
12. Practicality of coding to be initiated by giving them topics of day to day relevance.
