Details : The workshop conducted by KIPS was held at Royal Cliff on the topic of Artificial Intelligence and Robotics. The session started at 9:30 a.m. on 14th December 2019, with the registration process. Mr. Jitendra Singh, associated with ICT technique at IITK briefed the teachers about the session. He segregated the entire workshop into four segments, which were Artificial intelligence, Machine learning, Deep learning and Data sensing. He talked about the concepts of reinforced learning, training data, historical data. He also explained how the technology has advanced and now not only the structured data but also the unstructured data is being analysed to predict various situations. He made all understand the concept of AI in the field of robotics, shared videos about artificial intelligence and the robot Sophia. Both advantages and disadvantages of AI on our lives were also discussed. The elaboration was done on how is AI an ML learning and understanding it can lead us towards technological advancements. The last segment Data Science was explained as a combination of AI, ML and DL. It is a scientific way to analyse and process the data. It has two parts descriptive analysis that tells what had happened and Predictive analysis that predicts the data for the future using AI. He discussed the various applications that have been implemented using AI and ML like the Pilotless planes, drones, speech recognition software, face recognition software etc.

She informed all that Classes III, V and VIII will be soon formally assessed. Worksheets of different activities were provided to the teachers so as to diagnose the children as per their needs. She emphasized that the teachers should make changes in their current pedagogical process and cater the student's accordingly. For Classes IX to XII she focused on the Writing Skills. The CBSE circulars for the upcoming session were also highlighted. The Oxford University Press also launched their revised books as per the CBSE curriculum.
