## 1. Activity Report:

Date: 3 February 2020

**Event** : Founders Day Celebration

SPSEC organized a special assembly on 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2020 to celebrate its **Details** Founder's Day in the school and pay tribute to the School's Founder Sir Padampat Ji Singhania. Sir Padampat Ji Singhania, the great humanist and philanthropist, the founder of J.K. Organization, was born on 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 1905. The programme commenced with the chants of mantras, lighting of the lamp and garlanding the portrait of Sir Sahebji by the Principal, Mrs Bhawna Gupta and the Vice Principals, Mrs Kavita Chadha (Senior Wing) and Mrs Divya Mehta (Junior Wing).
