**Details** : An Online Webinar on NEP commenced with the brief introduction and welcome of the Resource Person. The Principals were explained about the new National Education Policy that seeks to introduce and implement a sea of changes across all levels of education in India, including the essential understanding of education in the country. It also seeks to implement changes in the way the facilitators of such education-schools, colleges and teachers-are trained and how they approach education. The policy is based on the pillars of "access, equity, quality, affordability, accountability" and will transform India into a "vibrant knowledge hub". The NEP changes the existing 10+2 structure of school education to a 5+3+3+4, covering children between the ages of 3-18.

NEP claims to make the education system holistic, flexible, multi-disciplinary aligned to the needs of the 21st century. It aims at bringing transformational changes in the Indian education system with a global perspective. It will include 12 years of schooling and three years of Anganwadi and pre-schooling.
