Details : A webinar on Active Learning Strategies for Authentic Classroom Engagement was organized for the teachers teaching classes I to XII. The resource person Ms Deepti Sawhney spoke about the New Education Policy and emphasised on experiential learning of the child wherein the child experiences, analyses, evaluates and synthesises his/her own knowledge and understanding about a concept. She was of the opinion that children should enquire and research answers on their own instead of teachers giving them readymade answers. She stressed on the fact that teacher should ensure that child understands his/ her own strengths, weaknesses, likes, dislikes and their emotions and challenges so as to make them self-aware and ensure that self-led learning becomes easier. The expert concluded in the end by inspiring the educators that they are magicians and they have the power to mould the future of their students by implementing progressive pedagogies. The webinar proved enlightening for the participants.

Educational Technology in Teaching and Learning Active learning strategies for Authentic Classroom Engagement Making learning visible

Webinar's objectives -

- To discuss, analyse and model visible learning strategies
- To try and predict the progression of chosen concept using some of these strategies
- Mindfulness and empathy see learning happening through the eyes of the learner
- To facilitate self- regulation in learning

The Resource Person quoted John Hattie, "Every student deserves a great teacher, not by chance, but by design". She also highlighted to identify the instructional routines that have the biggest impact on student learning. These practices are 'visible' for teachers and students because they are implemented at the right moment in a student's learning process, and their effect is tangible. She also spoke about how to use the right approach of the right time, so that we can design classroom experiences and transfer phases of learning. Finally, the resource person concluded the programme by saying that the learners need to know what, why and how they are learning.

Keeping in mind the new Education policy to bring in transformational change in the teaching -learning scenario, following were the objectives of the webinar.

To shift the emphasis from teaching to learning.

To individualise and contextualise students' learning experiences.

To help students develop processes, skills and attitudes

To explore digital resources to design and create constructive learning activities with which students formulate and test their ideas, draw conclusions and inferences and convey their knowledge in a collaborative environment.

Later, the resource person discussed about Designing Remote learning Lessons. Further components to design effective lesson plans were told which involves-

Engage Explore

Explain

Elaborate

Evaluate

All steps were explicitly explained to create a sound learning environment. The concept of **Constructivism** was brought forth by her, which involves learning based on observation and scientific study. In this way, the students are motivated to construct their own understanding and knowledge of the world through experiencing things and reflecting on these experiences. Here the teacher plays a significant role as the constructivist teacher who provides activities which involve problem solving and enquiry based learning. Emphasis was also given on Collaborative Activities where the teacher should play the role of a facilitator and motivate students to write what they have understood. The resource person also shared the template and the word document and also explained the process to upload the lesson plan on Google classroom. It was indeed an informative webinar.
