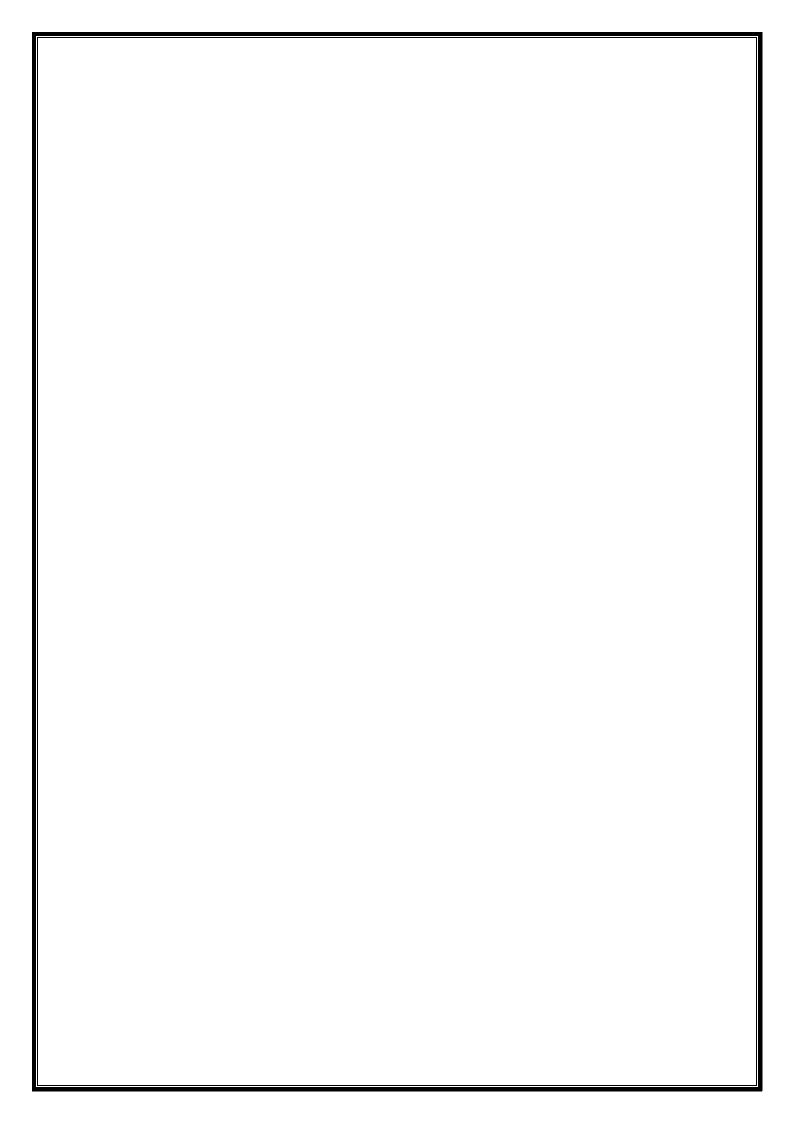

Details: Our school in an association with The Indian Orthopedic Association had organized a Webinar 'Safety on Road' on the topic 'Save SELF Save ONE', said that the link between proper first aid and basic life support immediately after an accident is missing and it has provided training to students, police personnel and other citizens to help them become life saviors.

The school Principal, Ms. Bhawna Gupta formally welcomed guest speaker who was an alumnus of SPSEC, Dr. Rohit Nath M.B.B.S, M.S. (Orthopedics), MRCS (Glasgow), DNB (Ortho), MNAMS (Ortho), Professor in G.S.V.M. Medical College Kanpur and L.L.R. Hospital Kanpur and the keynote speaker was Dr. Ravi Garg, MBBS, MS (Orthopedics) Gold medalist, Assistant Prof. in G.S.V.M. Medical College, Kanpur, AO Fellow in Germany and he has been in the field of medicine & Orthopedics since 20 years. Dr. Garg's areas of specialization include Arthroplasty, Spine Surgery, Minimally Invasive & Complex Trauma Surgery. He is the Director and Head of the Joint Replacement/Orthopedic unit at 'Abha Superspeciality Hospital & Garg Ortho and Gynae Centre in Kanpur. Dr. Garg is also working as Secretary of Kanpur Orthopedic Association & an Executive member of UP Orthopedic Association. Dr. Ravi Garg discussed the operational activities and moto of Indian Orthopedic Association is operational to edify and expound children above 9, the public and the police on first aid / basic life saving about roadside golden hour management of trauma patients. He especially focused on the importance of the golden time for the injured after the accident.

Dr. Rohit Nath accentuated the adoption and enforcement of traffic laws that appear inadequate in India. The development and effective enforcement of legislation are critical in reducing drink-driving and excessive speed, and in increasing the use of helmets, seatbelts, and child restraints. Dr. Nath highlighted the Good Samaritan Law incorporated in the MV Amendment Act 2019 to help road accident victims.

The students were also encouraged to reflect on how they would help in future to ensure road safety for all, and the webinar reached its end with a vote of thanks to the dignitaries of the occasion, audience, students and teachers who were present on the virtual platform to fabricate a successful webinar.

Meeting with Pre- Primary Teachers

The curriculum of Root, Bud and Bloom was reviewed and following suggestions were made:

- 1. The school must work on inverse pyramid admission structure with an increased number of admissions in Pre- Primary.
- 2. As being practiced, more emphasis should be given in future also on oratory, discipline, extracurricular activities, story- telling sessions, aerobics, yoga etc.
- 3. Teachers to observe the strengths and weaknesses of each child. A team of teachers will compile the student's observation report. The performance of the child will then be discussed with the coordinator/HM.
 - Parents to be apprised about the progress of the child. Teachers and Parents to work in unison and help the child overcome his weaknesses.
 - Learning gaps to be identified and action plan of the same to be implemented.
- 4. A fully equipped room to be created in Pre- Primary block for the story telling sessions.
- 5. Identification of minimum ten human values that the students of S.P.S.E.C. should imbibe. The same shall be discussed in detail in the next management meeting.
- 6. A trained instructor for Yoga and Aerobics to be appointed for the students and even the parents can be benefitted from the same. Parents may also become a part of the yoga sessions

Meeting with class 10 and 12 Teachers

The Vice Chairman, Mr. Partho P. Kar addressed the P.G.T. and T.G.T. facilitators and congratulated them for procuring splendid board results in both AISSCE AND AISSE for the session 20120-21. Sir expressed

his elation for notching the National Toppers in Class X, not just one but three students of Class X bagged the same position.

Subject-wise power point presentation was shared for all subjects with Comparative Analysis of the board result of the session 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

The Vice Chairman Sir emphasised to the teachers that the Internal Certification must be excellent through our connect with IIT, Kanpur. - 8. Learning outcomes have been successfully incorporated in classes 1 to 8 which need to be reviewed from time to time. Now we must start working on the same in the remaining classes i.e. Root Bud Bloom and Classes 9 to 12.
- 9. After discussing with the management, the three National Toppers of class 10 Board result of session 2020-21 will be felicitated in a special ceremony which will be informed to us later.
- 10. It was also recommended to felicitate the toppers of classes 10 and 12 for both sessions 2019-20 and 2020-21 on the Founder's Day on a virtual platform as these could not be awarded due to covid 19.
- 11. It was recommended to increase the length and frequency of the written assignments.
- 12. Teachers must make extensive use of Plagiarism software and Grammarly app for the purpose of improved academics.
- 13. The school should be ready for both offline and online tests depending on the prevalent conditions.
- 14. Testing on Hybrid model to continue for better dispensation of academics.
- 15. The teachers should share the answer script of google quizzes of the students who have secured full marks in various subjects.
- 16. Pre-recorded tapes of lectures should be maintained.
- 17. Negative marking concept for one assessment to be incorporated in Google assignment in order to judge the actual academic performance of the students.
- 18. Emphasis on digitalization of school library.
- 19. English Lab needs to be upgraded.
- 20. Mathematics Lab must be set up.
- 21. The Virtual Parent Teacher Meeting should be a regular feature.

Meeting with the Admission Team

- 22. The school should take admissions only in classes ROOT TO 1 and class 11. In other classes only if a child is extra ordinarily bright or a transfer case, the admission can be considered.
- 23. The management will decide upon the viability of the Hostel facility for the outstation students to be initiated in future.
- 24. To hold camps in adjoining places for promoting/marketing the infrastructure/facilities provided at SPSEC for enhancing admissions.
