## **MONTHLY SCHOOL REPORT – JULY 2021**

#### **ACTIVITIES**

Date : 28 June – 02 July 2021

**Event : First Term Test** 

Classes : VI – VIII

**Details**: SPSEC conducted Test 1 from 28th June to 2nd July for its students of Grades VI-VIII for the academic session 2021-22. The test was carried out in all the subjects i.e. English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies. The 25 marks test comprised two parts – Objective of 10 marks that was conducted in the Google Forms where MCQs were asked. Part 2 was Subjective type that carried 15 marks. Before the commencement of tests, thorough revisions were taken up during the live classes, revision sheets including objective and subjective practice material along with videos including explanation of the practice material were shared in the Google Classroom. Students' doubts were also clarified.

Classes: Root, Bud, and Bloom:

The teachers were made aware of the way they can take up the books as there are objective questions as well as e resource for students as well as teachers. This material aims to build higher order thinking skills and other 21st century skills as critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication. The books also contain a lot of Vocabulary based practice. For classes I- V play based learning and discovery-based learning activities have been included. Extra practice of Speaking and Listening skills has been included for students of Classes VI- VIII. There is additional practice in the Workbook with Dynamic Question Bank. The Teachers Resource includes Teaching Tips, Pedagogical notes, Slide show explanations, Printable Worksheets, Suggested Activities, and the Answer Key. Notes on teaching reading, detailed lesson plans and audios and animations, editable test papers are some key features of the Teacher's Resource.
