Date : **01 November 2021**
Event : **Lit N Lites - A Diwali Party**
Classes : **Root, Bud & Bloom**

Details : The pre-primary section of our school witnessed hearty bonding by celebrating Diwali through virtual platform on Monday, November 01, 2021. It commenced with a special assembly which was followed by a short explanation on Diwali festival symbolizing the triumph of good over evil, light over darkness and a new beginning.

The students were told the story of Lord Rama that how he returned to his kingdom from an exile of 14 years, with his wife, Sita and brother Laxman. Event : **Term 1 – Objective Exams**

Details : Our school had organized ‘Scientifique’, a science activity, for the students of classes I to V. The motive of this activity was to deepen the understanding of Science and assert its importance. Keeping the convenience and safety of students in mind, the event was held on **both online and offline modes**. A series of activities and video presentations were done on the online mode. The experiments with power point presentations and the model presentation on offline captivated all. All these activities were enjoyed by the students immensely.

In classes 1 and 2, the teacher first introduced the activity to the students who had opted the online mode and made the students familiar with routine of the event. To create a better understanding of the objective, a video consisting of an engaging story and the biography of scientist, was also shown to the students. They performed the live demonstration of experiments like ‘Air Occupies Space’, ‘Air Pressure’. A video involving the recent inventions was show to the students. This was followed by AMAZING FACTS, RIDDLES, and a VIDEO on EXPERIMENTS.

In classes 3 to 5 also, the teacher introduced the activity and the procedure regarding the same was explained. A story was narrated about a scientist that drew the students closer to their ambitions and inspired them. A student showed a presentation created by him/her. After that the students were acquainted with the recent inventions, with the help of a video. Another student presented his/ her work in the form of a video. To make the activity fun, AMAZING FACTS, RIDDLES and EXPERIMENTS were shown through videos.

For the students attending the school on the offline mode, Live experiments based on Water Density, Air Pressure and general concept of Polymers were carried out with power point presentations for classes from 3 to 5. The experiments were exciting, and the students were delighted to do those on their own. Observing the magic and wonders of science the model presentations of the ‘Water Cycle’, ‘Life- cycle’ of a Butterfly and the Effect of Field Electromagnet were shown. The teachers explained about the harmful effects of plastic and also the use of green and blue dustbins to segregate waste in classes 1 and 2.
