The different types of number plates are-

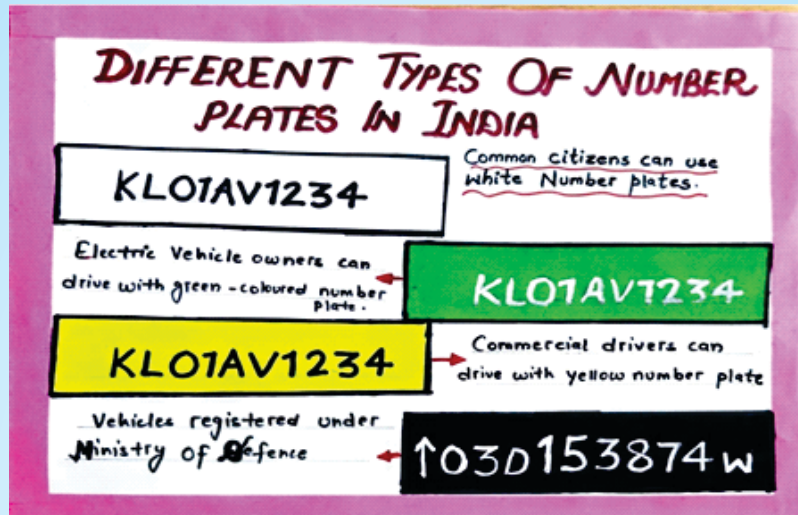
- * White number plate
