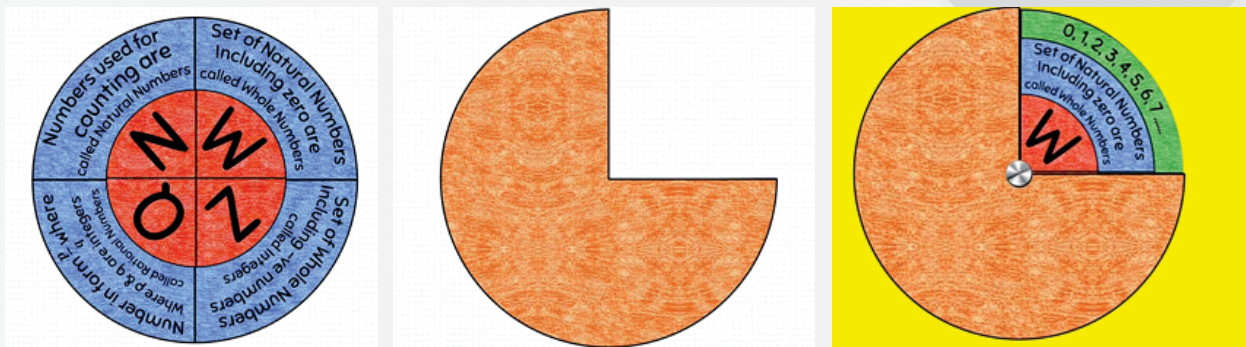

For eg:- The fifth National Family Health Survey (NFHS-5, survey data 2019-2021) mentioned that for every 1,000 men, India has 1,020 women.

It has also been found that the sex ratio is better in rural areas compared to urban centres. This is indicative of the fact that the stereotype of woman as a burden is slowly vanishing from the society, thus, giving way to the nation based on the principle of gender equality. Similarly, age-sex pyramid is very important to frame the policies and plans for the country.
