## LEARNING STEPS

### Independence & Life Skills

Encourage Your Child to:

- Dress up with minimal help
- Arrange toys after playtime
- Eat food independently using spoon/fork
- Fill their water bottle with assistance
- Keep their surroundings neat and tidy



### Reading & Speaking Time

Help your child to:

- Read colourful storybooks daily
- Encourage your child to describe pictures
- Ask simple questions from the story
- Motivate them to narrate in their own words



### Social & Communication Skills

Help your child to:

- Greet everyone with a smile
- Use polite words: Please, Thank you, Sorry
- Speak simple sentences like:

\*May I come in?

\*I am hungry.

\*Please help me.

-Play and share with friends



### Fine Motor & Creative Skills

Assist your child to:

- Practise colouring within boundaries
- Do simple activities like tearing, pasting, and threading
- Build with blocks or clay to improve hand strength and creativity



# Hands-on Learning

## Music & Movement Fun

### Fun steps:

- Play rhymes or soft music
- Encourage clapping, jumping, and dancing
- Use simple actions like "clap-tap-turn"
- Let children imitate animal movements



## Clay & Dough Play

### Let us Try:

- Give playdough or flour dough
- Ask the child to roll, press, and shape
- Make simple items like balls, snakes, or fruits
- Encourage naming what they create



## Mirror Talk

### Fun in Action:

- Let the child stand in front of a mirror
- Ask them to identify body parts
- Practice expressions (happy, sad, surprised)
- Encourage simple self-introduction



## Role Play Corner

### Let us Do This:

- Set up pretend play (kitchen, doctor, shop)
- Use simple props from home
- Encourage conversation during play
- Build imagination and social skills



## Picture Talk Time

### Ways to Explore:

- Show a simple picture or book
- Ask, What do you see?
- Encourage naming objects and actions
- Build small sentences together



## Sorting Fun

### Hands-on Experience:

- Provide mixed objects (buttons, beads, toys)
- Ask the child to sort by colour, size, or type
- Use bowls or boxes for grouping
- Count each group together



# Hands-on Learning

## Shape Hunt

### Enjoy This Activity:

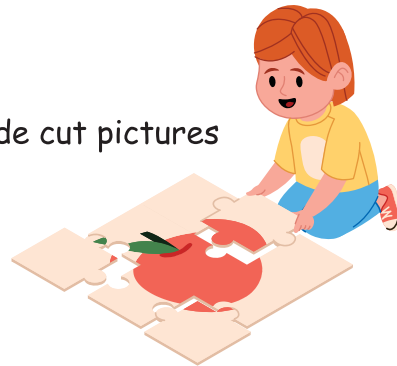
- Pick one shape (circle, square, triangle)
- Ask the child to find objects of that shape at home
- Trace the shape on paper
- Match objects with drawn shapes



## Simple Puzzle Time

### Play & Learn Steps:

- Give 2-4 piece puzzles or homemade cut pictures
- Help the child assemble
- Encourage problem-solving
- Appreciate effort



## Colour Mixing Fun

### Time to Explore:

- Use safe colours (watercolours/food colours)
- Mix two colours (red + yellow = orange)
- Let the child experiment
- Talk about new colours



## Water Painting Magic

### Let us Discover:

- Give a brush and a bowl of water
- Let the child paint on walls, floor, or paper
- Watch how it disappears as it dries
- Talk about wet and dry



## Action Word Game

### Let us Do This:

- Say actions like jump, clap, run
- Child performs the action
- Reverse roles—child gives instructions
- Build vocabulary



## Line Walking Game

### Enjoy This Activity:

- Draw a straight or zigzag line on floor
- Ask the child to walk on it
- Try balancing with arms stretched
- Improves coordination
