ELIGIBILITY

Age: The student should be within the particular age group as on **31.12.2026**.

- (a) Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School Tournament. Participation of any non-bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- (b) A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
- (c) Incomplete information in any respect may lead to disqualification of team.
- (d) Any violation in eligibility (over age or Impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- (e) Medical checkup may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by the Organising school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- (f) A student shall be **under 14, 17, & 19** years of age as on **31.12.2026** of the year of event. Accordingly, for **session 2026-27** sports events, the age criteria will be as follows:

1. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2013

2. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2010

3. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2008

IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT THE HOST SCHOOL: -

- (i) The documents for verification in original if asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Proforma, countersigned by the school Principal.
- (iii) To provide CBSE registration number for participating students.
- (iv) To provide the eligibility proforma filled-in online, counter signed by the school Principal.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player/team may be disqualified for the following reasons:

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- 2. Inclusion of non-bonafide student in the team.
- 3. Misbehaviour under any circumstances by any student or accompanying official.
- 4. Use of foul language by student or accompanying official.
- 5. Misbehaviour with Officials/Opponents by student/s or accompanying official/s.
- 6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by student/s or accompanying official/s.
- 7. Damaging the school property.
- 8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by student/s or accompanying official/s.

GENERAL IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Escort/Coach/Team Team Manager shall be held responsible for their student's behaviour and use of indecent language. The same shall be reported to their School Principal/Management.
2. At the time of game in progress, players should stay away from the field arena.
3. Player must give attendance prior to the scheduled match as requested by the Chief Officials.
4. It is mandatory for all Coaches / Team Managers / Players to wear accreditation card during days of meet irrespective they are in or out of the school campus.
5. Participating schools shall deposit the meal charges for all three days (Rs. 1,500 per head) in a single payment at the time of registration. No part payment will be accepted
6. Escorts, Coaches and Team Managers are expected to maintain their student's discipline.
7. Players movement after 09:00 p.m. outside their accommodated room shall not be allowed.
8. It is mandatory for all Coaches and Team Managers to stay with the students in the allotted rooms.
9. Bringing or use of tobacco sachets, cigarettes, liquor or any illicit material is strictly prohibited in the school campus.
10. The host school is not responsible for any incident that happens out of school campus during outing of any Coach/Team Manager/Team or Players.
11. No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline-wise online Entry Proforma and No offline entry shall be entertained.
12. No team will be permitted to play unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.
13. Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.
14. Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation.
15. Every player / athlete/ team shall carry with them the required documents as mentioned under title **"Eligibility"**.
16. Every team will carry their one school flag for the purpose of various ceremonies.
17. Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be submitted in writing to **Organising Secretary** at school@spsec.co.in and the **CBSE Observer** within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of **Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand)**.
18. The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.
19. Parents' entry into the tournament venue is respectfully restricted.

TABLE TENNIS RULES

(BOYS & GIRLS)

1. All the matches will be played according to the rules of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) as adopted by them from time to time, with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under14, Under17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys & Girls category.
3. In Boys Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum three players.
4. In Girls Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum three players.
5. The order of play shall be as follows:

Boys & Girls' Category Separately	
(i)	A v/s X
(ii)	B v/s Y
(iii)	C v/s Z
(iv)	A v/s Y
(v)	B v/s X

6. The matches up to quarter final stage will be played as best of three sets. Semi- final & final matches will be played as best of five sets.
7. The balls to be used in the tournament shall be TTFI approved.
8. From each Cluster, the First Position winning team and First Runner-Up in each age group separately in Boys & Girls Category, shall qualify to participate in the CBSE Nationals.
9. No change in composition of team from Cluster level to National level will be allowed.
10. The school Organising Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams/Individual Players that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school Organising next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
11. At Cluster level the tournament will be organised on knockout basis.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP – AT CLUSTER

- (a) In addition to the team championship, separate Individual Championship will be conducted at each Cluster level.
- (b) At Cluster, the Individual Championship shall be organised on knock out basis.
- (c) In Cluster Individual Championship, only the schools that are participating as a 'team', shall be eligible to allow any one player to play in Individual Championship in each category separately for boys & girls. However, if there is only one player from a school, he/she may be allowed to participate in individual championship. Similarly, if a school has only two players, then one player out of these two will be eligible to participate in individual championship.
- (d) The scoring system will be the same as mentioned above.
- (e) From each Cluster, top 4 players in each age-group and category shall qualify to participate in CBSE Nationals.

IMPORTANT

1. Players can take time out for one minute, once in whole match.
2. Expedite system shall come into operation if a game is unfinished after 10 minutes play. If the expedite system is introduced, all subsequent games of the match shall be played under the expedite system.
3. Play shall be continuous throughout a match except that a player is entitled to:
 - (a) An interval of up to one minute between successive games of a match.
 - (b) Brief intervals for toweling after 6 points from the start of each game and at the change of ends in the last possible game of a match.
